*It's in the moutain: make sure to bring suitable clothes for cold and rainy weather as well as flashlights. There is no shower facilities provided (the river and some organic soap are an alternative to be considered). Feel free to bring your own rations. You will find food at eating hours and if you're thirsty the bar will serve beer, wine and softs throughout the festival.*

## How to get there

Échos takes place in the heights of **Le Saix**, Hautes-Alpes (France - 05).

To come to the festival, the first step is to reach the village called Le Saix. From there, **you can walk to the location of the festival** by following the marks through the village and the canyon (about an hour's walk).

### By car

Once you're in Le Saix, there is **a parking lot dedicated to the festival**, on the D49 road, at the entrance of the village. For security reasons, cars are not allowed to drive further.

From south (Serres, Chabestan): the parking lot is on the right side, 400 meters previous the village's entrance.

From Veynes: turn right just before the village staying on the D49 road, then slightly turn right again. The parking lot is 300 meters further on the left side.

### By train

The nearest station to Le Saix is **Veynes** (10 km from the spot), directly accessible by train from Grenoble, Gap, Valence, Briançon, Marseille.

Once in Veynes, you may reach Le Saix by **hitchhiking or carpooling**.
